BIOGRAPHY

Dr. Angela Mund is the President of the American Association of Nurse Anesthesiology.

Dr. Mund has been a registered nurse for over 30 years and a certified registered nurse anesthetist (CRNA) for 24 years. She received a certificate in Nurse Anesthesia from the Minneapolis Veteran's Affairs School of Nurse Anesthesia in 1998. She graduated from the University of Minnesota with a Master of Science degree in 1999 and a Doctor of Nursing Practice degree in 2008.

She has been very active in nurse anesthesiology education, practice, and leadership for over 20 years including serving as President of the Association of Veteran's Affairs Nurse Anesthetists and the President of the South Carolina Association of Nurse Anesthetists as well as on several American Association of Nurse Anesthesiology (AANA) Committees.

Currently, Dr. Mund is the Chair for the Department of Clinical Sciences at the Medical University of South Carolina (MUSC), leading a team of faculty and staff from the physician assistant, nurse anesthesia, cardiovascular perfusion, healthcare studies, and genetic counseling programs. Her areas of scholarship are healthcare policy and cardiovascular anesthesia. She has provided academic leadership including President of the MUSC Faculty Senate.

Dr. Mund served in US Army Reserve Nurse Corps for 10 years (1996–2006) and provided clinical anesthesia in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operating Enduring Freedom.
